



Yeshua's disciples prepared for and prepared the Passover lamb on Tuesday and Tuesday evening ate the seder. Afterwards, they went to the Garden of Gethsemane on the Mount of Olives. Yeshua was arrested, taken to the Sanhedrin and judged before sunrise. He was then taken to Pilate and condemned to die by the crowds later in the morning. By the afternoon on Tuesday he was on the cross. He died at the third hour or about 3 p.m. in the afternoon at the time of the final evening Passover sacrifice. He was taken off the cross and put in the tomb before Unleavened Bread began at sunset on Wednesday. This probably took some time making the hour he was placed in the tomb between 4 and 5 p.m. still before sunset. He was in the tomb three days and three nights as per the 'sign of Jonah.' Sometime before sunset on the 'third day', he rose from the dead as the Firstfruits offering. Thus, Yeshua fulfilled these spring 'appointed times.'
